Notes:-

A village of about twenty houses on the south western shore of the Burry Estuary. It is sheltered on the west side by an impressive limestone outcrop rising 200 feet above sea level. The ruins of the 15th Century Bovehill Castle are situated on this ridge, overlooking the village and Landimore Marshes.

The village has development informally along tree lined sunken lanes, one of which descends steeply to the shore, and the buildings though simple in character are less austere than those on the higher, more exposed parts of the peninsula.

They are generally of local materials, having rendered walls and slated roofs.

The village enjoys a secluded atmosphere and has a character which would respond to the careful implementation of conservation principles.
