Notes:-

Set into the slope on corner of Quarry Street.

Dated 1885. Architect not known. French Second Empire Style. Tall, symmetrical three-storey and attic, three bay front to Alexandra Road, pale stone dressings with red brick facings. Advanced centre bay under segmental and finial, bipartite window set against curved and leaded platform roof with ornamental ironwork. Outer pedimental dormers set into hipped slate roof. Dentilled eaves, impost and cill bands, long and short quoins, banded rustication to lower storeys of centre bay.

Tripartite window over two light traceried first floor window to centre bay, paired outer windows; all round headed with key blocked architraves, roll moulded and fluted jambs carved roundels to first floor spandrels. Entablature and part fluted pilasters to centre doorcase, panelled doors up steps.

Similar treatment to long side elevation stepped uphill in Quarry Street, pedimented frontispiece with offset panelled chimney-stack to dormer, bipartite window over doorway, seven bay elevation to right.
