Attached by Cloister/corridor to east of St Joseph's Church.

1886-8. Designed by Pugin and Pugin, Architects of London, as part of original scheme.

Two storey asymmetrical building, forward to right. Rubble facings, bath stone dressings, quoins, hipped slate roofs with end stacks. Two and three light mullioned windows, arched head to ground floor left. Two-storey porch in angle. Attached range with linking corridor runs left to join church, timber work bargeboards, second doorway etc. Walled forecourt.
