### **Notes:-**

Terrace of late Georgian Houses making up most of the west side of the street.

Early/mid 19<sup>th</sup> Century, later alterations.

Three-storey and basement cemented roughcast fronts, two bays each house, slightly breaking forward on the right. Slate roofs with brick stacks behind parapet with moulded capping, cill band over ground floor, exposed rubble basements. Sash windows with small-frame glazing.

Left hand arched and rusticated doorcases with traceried fanlights (removed No.1), double panel doors reached by flying platforms over railed areas.

Partly in poor state of repair at time of inspection (spring 1986).
