Notes:-

Set against hillside on corner of Heathfield, a scarce domestic survivor of late Georgian Swansea.

Late 18th Century, built for Edward Hughes (who had built the demolished Heathfield House), late additions.

Three-storey L-plan stucco front with range forward to right, low one-storey extension in angle. Hipped slate roofs, moulded eaves, three windows, wide architraves with keyblocks to ground and first floors, sashes with small-pane glazing, balconies to three window left side. Doorway under arched hood on fluted brackets, three windows to right.
