### **Notes:-**

Set back from and above the road with service road behind trees on street line. Originally known as Brunswick Place.

Terrace of mid 19<sup>th</sup> century classical houses (originally arranged as two pairs plus one), centre left block with later five-light cantilevered Tudor Bay over linking porches. Three-storey plus attic and basement, stucco two-bay fronts linked by one-storey porches. Slate roofs, gables dormers and central panelled stacks. Eaves cornice and blocking course, plain pilasters over main cornice, Corinthian pilasters below. Windows with architraves and cornices on volute brackets to ground floor. Large later splayed bay through all storeys to no. 148, two-storey splayed bay to left side. Sash windows with small-pane glazing (not nos. 139, 140 and 147). Ionic columns in antis to side porches, panelled doorcases under, steps up. Long ranges to rear.
