Notes:-

Now located at the Rutland Street entrance to modern shopping precinct; originally at Castle Square, thereafter moved 1936 to Victoria Park and to present site, 1982.

Sculpture dated 1884. Designed by M Raggi sculptor of London; made by H. Young & Co., founders of Pimlico. Unveiled by Lord Aberdare, 1886.

Tall, square red granite pedestal with moulded cornice and base, chamfered angles. Bronze standing figure of Sir H. Hussey Vivian Bart, M.P., First Baron Swansea of Singleton; topcoat and outstretched right hand, left holding a scroll, pile of books to rear.
