Notes:-

On quayside close to south-east corner of main basin of South Dock and now forming the centrepiece to a modern courtyard opposite the Maritime Museum.

Dated 1857, originally located in centre of courtyard at the Old Guildhall. Relocated in present position 1985. Statue designed by I. Evan Thomas, sculptor, cast by Robinson & Cottam, Statue Foundry, Pimlico.

Stepped granite plinth and tall pedestal with moulded base and cornice. Full height, bronze, standing figure in top-coat carrying papers in right hand, draped heraldic pedestal to rear.
