### **Notes:-**

At pierhead on west bank of the River Tawe and downstream from locks at entry to South Dock.

Late 19<sup>th</sup> century (possibly ca 1880). Compact two storey red brick structure with tall crenellated (outlook) tower to north end. Slate roofs (stripped at time of inspection). Segmental arched window heads to first floor, lunettes to ground floor, fixed small-pane glazing. Brace-plates to tower top; plinth, outside stair with ironwork handrail to first floor boarded doors. Small one storey gabled extension to south end. Boarded interior to upper room with panelled doors.

Undergoing restoration at time of inspection (May 1986).
