### **Notes:-**

In a row of frontages towards foot of street.

1910-12. Designed by Waller and Son, architects of Gloucester.

Edwardian classicism. Three-storey and attic, five bay façade. Portland stone, slate roof, tall gable end stacks. Advanced and banded outer bays with giant Corinthian half columns to recessed centre bays; bracket cornice with balustraded and panelled parapet, similar treatment over ground floor. Moulded architraves, swagged aprons linked outer storeys, pediments with cherub panels to centre first floor windows. Rusticated ground floor with cavetto-arched openings and keyblocks, originally tripartite glazing with radiating fanlights, double doors to left.
