On the corner with Bryn Terrace.

Ca 1900. Twin tower Gothic façade. Sneaked rubble with pale freestone dressing, slate roofs. Wide three bay façade, parapetted gable with heavy finial to centre, two-light window with cill-band course over large five-light Geometric west window with hoodmould. Gabled porch rises through main cill, entrance with two filleted orders, nook shafts with bushy capitals, blind tracery to tympanum over paired shouldered doorways. Square, buttressed outer towers; to north with French slate roof and ironwork cresting elongated eaves brackets; to south with corbelled bell storey, pierced parapets, polygonal finials and paired lancets with centre shafts. Lower storeys with tall two-light windows over paired narrow lancets.

Buttresses side elevation with bracket eaves and giant two-light traceried windows with blind panels for gallery backs. Narrow forecourt with Gothic finials to piers, modern railings.
