### **Notes:-**

Ornamental garden building on small overgrown hillock to SW of road, formerly in parkland of (demolished) Sketty Park House.

Probably designed by William Jernagan, architect, of Swansea, who designed Sketty Park House (1806).

Gothic prospect tower of octagonal plan (imitating mediaeval chapter house). Rubble-faced walls with droved freestone dressings, taller polygonal stair turret to NW angle. Panelled parapets (broken) over eaves stringcourse, diagonal corner buttresses with set-offs, pointed chamfered lights with dripmoulds, Y-tracery facing road. Tall (blocked) chamfered archway on W side; pointed (blocked) doorway to stair turret with corbelled top and cross loops.

Remarkable vaulted interior with central ribbed pier and wall shafts supporting slender ribs to centralised brick vaults.

In derelict condition at time of inspection.
