### **Notes:-**

#### ***Location:-***

At the side of a lane at the centre of Lunnon, behind Big House Farmhouse.

#### ***History:-***

Possibly contemporary with Big House Farmhouse of c1700, to the farmyard entrance of which it is adjacent. Marked as 'pound' on 1877 map.

#### ***Exterior:-***

A small animal pound in coursed axe-dressed local limestone, approximately oval in plan with a gateway at the north end. The walls of the pound are about 1½m high. Simple iron gate.

#### ***Listed:-***

Included as a rare and well preserved village pound for the retention of stray animals.
